I'm reaching out on behalf of the Patient Outcome Reporting Tool for emergency medical services (PORTAL) team at Vanderbilt. PORTAL is a tool that delivers clinical care feedback and automated hospital-based outcomes to EMS providers. This tool is now live and can be used to review your practice patterns for patients with suspected Acute Coronary Syndrome. You can access PORTAL for free in your ESO account.

To access the PORTAL interface:

- 1) Login to your ESO account
- 2) Click on "Insights"
- 3) Click on "PORTAL-Acute Coronary Syndrome"
- 4) Review and learn from your practice patterns
